Candidates, Ballot Questions,
Political Action Committees, and Political Parties

Candidates and Ballot Questions

The first section summarizes how candidate and ballot question committees were financed during the 2013 Lincoln, Omaha, and other local Elections. The data was obtained from the Campaign Statements (NADC Form B-1) filed by the candidates and ballot question committees.

The city of Omaha held elections on April 2, 2013 and May 14, 2013. The city of Lincoln held elections on April 9, 2013 and May 7, 2013. Special (local) Elections were held on various dates.

In the summary, "Annuals" refers to annual campaign statements filed leading up and prior to the 2013 election year. "Primary" refers to campaign statements filed for the primary election. "General" refers to campaign statements filed for the general election. "Receipts from Others" includes contributions from Businesses, PAC's, and Political Parties. "Receipts from All Sources" also may include loans received or repaid and bank interest. "Won or Lost" next to Primary or General designates if the candidate won or lost the primary or general election.

Formation of a political committee was required upon raising, receiving or spending, more than \$5,000 within a calendar year to influence an election. Therefore, some candidates had no committees and some offices or ballot issues that appeared on the ballot may not be listed in this summary.
